

The event this year has been expanded with space for post card dealers as well as stamps, thematics and postal history.





Getting to MIDPEX

Leamington Spa Station is the nearest railway station that serves the venue with direct links from London and Birmingham stations. From there it is a 5 minute taxi ride or a little longer on the bus. London is just 1 hour away. Direct rail services are available from Birmingham, Coventry, North East, North West, South East and South West

We are also running a shuttle bus service from the railway station to the venue. It will depart from the main road directly opposite the entrance to the station at the following times:

Leaving the station at 9:15, 9:45, 10:15, 10:45, 11:15, 11:45, 12:15, 12:45, lunch, 14:00, 14:30

Then going back from the event centre at 12:30, 13:00, lunch, 14:15, 14:45, 15:15, 15:45, 16:30

Journey time is approx 10 minutes.
